SUMMARY

As recommended by the *Fort Worth Public Art Master Plan Update*, a new pre-qualified list of artists will be the primary source for artist selection for upcoming projects from the 2022 Bond Program, over the next 3-5 years. The first group of individuals listed below have agreed to serve on the review panel for the 2022 Prequalified Artist List Open Call. The second group has identified by staff as potential alternates. This diverse group of Review Panel Members and potential alternates were selected based on their experience and expertise in the areas of Public Art, Fine Art, Design, and Public Art Administration. Upon approval of the Art Commission staff will issue contracts to all panel members and schedule an orientation to clarify roles and expectations.
